SECRETARY REPORT

Unfortunately, we remained 1 board member, preferably from the Murray Playing Area short, and over the year were unable to find a person willing to fill that position, which had been vacant

since the formation of the GMBR, we will continue to search for the right person.

Grace Kenworthy showed her dedication to the role by attending all board, Delegates, Bowls Vic Meetings as well as attending State Events and Pennant Finals, as well as the Region Sides in Ballarat, getting to know the many members and delegates around our large Region.

BOARD MEETINGS

There were 7 Board meetings held over the past season with 6 held in the meeting room at the Shepparton Park Bowls Club and 1 at the Strathmerton Bowls Clubs; June, August, October, December, February, March and finally in April. On behalf of the board, I would like to express our thanks to those clubs allowing us the use of their facilities.

At our February meeting we met with Pat Schram (Bowls Victoria President), Tony Sherwill (Bowls Victoria CEO) and Josh Thornton (Country Manager Northern Victoria) for discussions regarding many items and the ladies from Shepparton Park provided a light afternoon tea for the board and guests.

COUNTRY MANGER PROGRAM

Following a successful 2-year trial involving the Murray-Mallee and Wimmera Regions, Josh Thornton, whilst retaining those two regions has come on board for the next 2 years as the Country Manager Northern Victoria for the Goulburn Murray, Bendigo Campaspe Goldfields and Ovens and Murray Regions for who he will be offering assistance in the following areas;

- Region relationships
- Region administration
- Region events & participation

Josh has recently attended our GMBR April Board Meeting and will be attending our Annual General Meeting (BV commitments permitting) as well as Playing Area Delegates meetings when his schedule permits, I look forward to working closely with him.

REGION MEMBERSHIP NUMBERS

It may seem disturbing to report that the Regions Membership numbers according to those registered on BowlsLink have seen a big decrease as at the 1st April 2024 of 168 from the registered 2221 of last season, to currently stand at 2053. However we did lose 60 members from Stanhope with their transfer to the Campaspe Playing Area of the BCGR. Our numbers stand at 1364 in the Goulburn Valley (down 125) and 689 (down 43) in the Murray, with numbers for individual clubs as listed.

BOWLSLINK

With 2054 members listed on Bowlslink only 1182 have their email addresses recorded, which means that there are 872 members not receiving our Monthly Newsletter. Whist I realise that not everyone has an email address I

would ask clubs to check up with their members lists and ensure all that do have emails have them recorded in Bowlslink.

There are still a few clubs, not many, who need to ensure that their side managers are able to, access and be proficient at, entering completed match results onto Bowlslink following their pennant games. The insertion of Pennant results into Bowlslink following games continues to show more managers are becoming aware that it is a relatively simple process with a BV Side Managers training video available at VID26 03 2 (youtube.com).

BOWLSLINK STATE GAME ENTRY & PAYMENT

At the time of writing this report we have a balance of \$30,511.28 in the account,







Throughout the season we had continued problems with player behaviour, especially aggressive language often directed at Umpires, who are volunteering their time for the game.

Such behaviour can be intimidating for some and can be a catalyst for them to withdraw from bowls altogether. Something none of us want to see happen.

Whilst there are penalties that can be applied for such behaviour, if an Umpire is already under stress from intimidation, it makes it very difficult for them to apply penalties.

It can't be left up to the Umpire of the day to try to stamp out such behaviour on their own. There needs to be more support from the offending players Club to say that aggressive behaviour is not the way we want our Club to be represented.

By working together we can improve standards on the green, Clubs would be aware of their players that are prone to offending, they should be taking some responsibility towards improving standards. I'm sure if Umpires were given some support from Clubs in this matter it would make a big difference.

We have been busy with new Umpire accreditations and re accreditations and I must thank Terry Crosier and Michael Loughead for their assistance.


Discussion has begun with the Board on the possibility of recognising the time and travel commitments by having some re imbursement for Umpires at State events and finals.
